Bob Simpson Provides the Keynote at the NAHMA March Meeting

Alexandria, Va., Feb. 11, 2025 — Bob Simpson, Multifamily Impact Council president, will be the keynote speaker at the National Affordable Housing Management Association (NAHMA) Biannual Top Issues in Affordable Housing [conference](#). The multiday meeting, taking place Wednesday, March 19-Friday, March 21, in Washington, D.C., will highlight panels concentrating on affordable housing practitioners' issues and educational topics for navigating today's world led by experts in their fields. The annual meeting features several educational panels geared explicitly toward the affordable housing industry. Simpson, a nationally recognized expert in affordable, green and healthy housing with over 25 years of experience working at the highest levels of housing finance and public policy, will provide the keynote presentation on Thursday, March 20.
